T: Yes, I am. R: Welcome to China, Mr. Anderson. I'm a luggage representative from Wuhan Youth Travel Agency. And you can call me Liu Song. T: Oh, Mr. Liu, thank you very much for coming here to help us with the luggage. R: You're welcome, Mr. Anderson.
