## 章节摘录

Zhang Er had been good friends with Chen Yu the Prince of Dai. In the widespread uprisings after the death of the First Emperor, they had joined the rebels together and had set up Zhao Xie, a descendant of the former royal house of Zhao, as Prince of Zhao.

Later, when Xiang Yu enfeoffed eighteen princes, he transferred Zhao Xie to be the Prince of Dai. Xiang Yu had taken a liking to Zhang Er, partly because Zhang was a sociable person with many friends; therefore he made Zhang Er Prince of Changshan, a part of the Zhao area. As for Chen Yu, who did not readily follow Xiang Yu's orders, he got only three counties as his fief and the title of marquis. Chen Yu was so angry that he took the first opportunity to attack Zhang Er, driving him out of the area of Zhao and reinstating Zhao Xie as Prince of Zhao. The grateful Zhao Xie thanked Chen Yu by offering him the area of Dai. In the ninth month, Han Xin and Zhang Er advanced on Dai and Zhao, which were neighboring areas divided by the Taihang Mountains. They first attacked Dai, which lay to the west of the mountains, engaging the Dai army at Yuyu (modern northwest Heshun County in Shanxi Province). The Dai army was routed and Xia Yue was taken prisoner. As soon as the battle was over, the King of Han hastily sent an envoy to take command of Han Xin's best troops and bring them back to Xingyang to reinforce his own army. Left with twenty or thirty thousand men, Han Xin and Zhang Er led them eastward, planning to attack Zhao by way of Jingxing Defile.
