Today, the Midwest is prospering with the resurgence of the automobile industry and the success of urban renewal projects to clean up and glamorize downtown regions for tourists and patrons of the arts. The economic highs of the 1990s brought prosperity, better jobs, more police protection, and lower crime rates which made the cities attractive again. Cleveland built the Rock-n-Roll Hall of Fame next to two new sports stadiums and a technology museum adjacent to where the cleaned-up Cuyahoga River flows into Lake Erie. Chicago remains central to the region as the third largest city in America and center for the nations commodities exchange. In 2001, Chicago put on an advertising blitz, announcing its intention of becoming the nations greenest and most environmentally friendly city by 2006. It is converting to solar and wind-powered generators to supply 20 percent of the citys energy needs, establishing bike paths, planting trees, subsidizing the installation of energy-efficient windows and doors, and raising fines on polluters, litterers and those who refuse to recycle (AP, 2001a). Such efforts are aimed at bringing new immigrants to the region. In 2001, for example, the state of Iowa, which is nearly 96 percent white and has the nations third oldest citizenry the average age is 58 - began a well-funded.
