Several significant cultural institutions have written letters supporting the cooperative, arguing that the cost of such a move would be financially onerous to a nonprofit entity with a small budget and could also endanger films in the collection. The New York Public Library, the American Film Institute in Los Angeles, the Andy Warhol Museum in Pittsburgh and the Fine Arts Library at Harvard are among those who have issued statements of support. "The co-op set the model for artists control over distribution of their own films, and continues to mean a tremendous amount to people working completely outside the commercial system," said P. Adams Sitney, author of Visionary Film: The American AvantGarde, 1943-2000 (Oxford University Press) and a professor of visual arts at Princeton. "They need space for all those films, especially in this difficult economic environment. This couldn't be happening at a worse time."
