插图：The Hall of Praying for a Good Harvest The Hall of Praying for a Good Harvest was the place where emperor prayed for a bumper harvest on the 15th of the first month of the Chinese lunar year every year in the Ming and Qing Dynasties. It was a round hall with the roof of gold-plating top, three posts and blue tiles, golden colored drawings and patterns, three-storied layers of eaves. This hall was adopted the structural form with the altar and with 32 meters high, 30 meters for the diameter, the triple eaves are shrank and bundled upwards and formed umbrella shape layer by layer. Standing on the altar of Praying for Corn with about 6 meters high, encircled by white fence of stone carving of three layers. The hall is grandeur and pageantry, well-known at home and abroad, and also is the symbol and sign of Beijing. The Hall of Praying for a Good Harvest was underproped and connected by 28 columns supporting the sky and numerous complicated wooden shelves without any beam and iron nail. It is a remarkable model in the wooden framework building and a great wonder in classical timber building of the world, has extremely high science and artistic value. This hall was built in the Yongle Year of Ming Dynasty, the original name was Daji Dian, presented the rectangle at first. And then rebuilt with the round hall with triple eaves, and cover blue, yellow and green three colored tiles one by one from top to bottom, named Daxiang Dian. In the 17th year of Qianlong reign in the Qing Dynasty ( 1752 ), determined as the name of today. At the same time, three color tiles changed into the unified dark blue glazed tiles, in order to symbolize the blue sky. In the 15th year of Guangxu reign in the Qing Dynasty ( 1889 ), this hall was destroyed by the thunder and fire, and rebuilt according to the former state in the next year.
