But this explanation seems to ignore the fact that only in 1993 did China go from being an energy exporter to an energy im- porter , and that since the People's Republic of Cluna was established in 1949 , the Sino-African relationship has been developing steadily and healthily and Africa has consistently been positioned highly in China's diplomacy. In addition , the current development of China's relationship with Africa is not confined to those resource- rich African countries , but with all African countries that have diplomatic relations with China. The direct beneficiaries of Chinese measures including debt deduc- tion , ero tariff treatment , and aid increase are those least-developed African coun- tries , most of which are not rich in resources. Obviously , although the need for resources is , in fact , one of the driving forces behind China's African policy , it is certainly not the only , nor is it the key factor. To objectively analyze the driving forces belund China's African policy , it isneeded to take a broader view and a comprehensive perspective as China's national characteristics , her national interest as well as her overall diplomatic strategy andthinking.
